

This helmet was worn by a bike rider who was involved in a crash.

The helmet lining is cracked.



This entire side of the inner lining was crushed in.

The impact of the crash caused the outer shell of the helmet to separate from the inner lining. The inner lining absorbed the energy, **leaving the brain and skull intact.**



Protect your child's brain.

Ask how your child can receive a free helmet from our pediatric clinic.

This helmet saved a Charlotte County man from a traumatic brain injury and may have saved his life. The rider suffered only broken ribs. Please always wear a helmet when riding a bike or skate boarding. Children under 16 must wear a helmet when riding a bike - ***it's the law.***
