- Scholarships for job training at approved schools
- Resume, interviewing, and job search workshops
- Career and skills assessment

So now you are wondering...

Who is eligible for the program?

- Terminated or laid off employees who are eligible for or have exhausted Unemployment and are unlikely to return to their previous occupation
- Displaced Homemakers who have been dependent on the income of a family member but are no longer supported by that income and are unemployed or underemployed and experiencing difficulty in obtaining employment

How are participants selected for the program?

- The Career Managers at the Career and Service Centers review applications to determine eligibility

How does it work?

- Participants attend job training at approved schools and colleges in order to obtain employment in targeted occupations.
- You will be asked to provide:
 - Driver's License
 - Social Security number
 - Selective Service registration (Males age 18 and over must be registered, option to register available at Centers)
 - DD 214 (if applicable)
 - Proof of layoff or potential layoff
